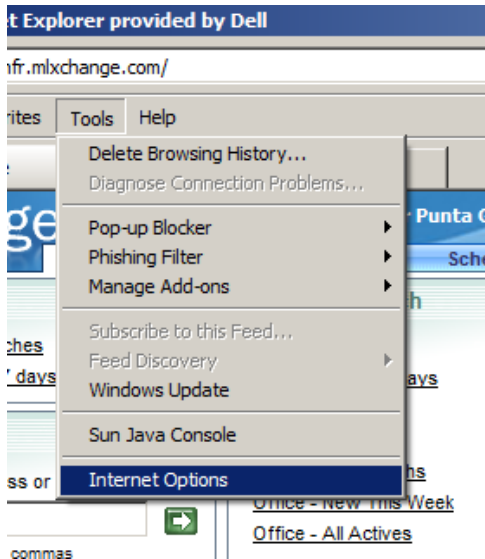


Delete Your PC Temporary Internet Files and History: Regular PC Maintenance.

As you surf the Internet, files are being stored in your Temporary Internet Files folder on your hard drive. Also, shortcuts to the pages you have viewed on the Internet are stored in your History Folder. If a large amount of files are allowed to build up in these folders, your system functionality and performance can be affected.

We recommend that you empty your Internet Temporary Files and History folder at least once a week. This practice should be part of your regular computer maintenance.



Open Internet Explorer, click on **Tools** and **Internet Options**.

On the General

Tab, click **Browsing History Delete Button**. Click **Delete Files** under **Temporary Internet Files & Cookie Files**. When done, click **Close** and **OK**. Close and reopen Internet Explorer.
