\_\_\_ **Awards (Million Dollar)** - The Awards Committee will review Million Dollar applications for the Association.

\_\_\_ **Commercial Committee** – The Commercial Committee provides the Commercial members an opportunity to meet and discuss issues and matters that affect their business.

\_\_\_ **Global Real Estate Connections** – This committee will provides those members interested in the International business an opportunity to meet, discuss issues and matters that affect their business and ability to do business. This committee works closely with the Professional Development committee to develop informational seminars for the membership.

\_\_\_ **Grievance Committee** - This committee is responsible to review ethics complaints received from the general public and from others in the industry about the conduct of a member in a real estate transaction. To participate on this committee, members must have been in Real Estate a minimum of 3 years. An appointment to this committee is a three year appointment.

\_\_\_ **Legislative and Government Affairs Committee** – Members who are interested in identifying issues affecting our industry and in promoting industry appropriate legislative issues with various local elected officials of our community involved with our industry would enjoy this group. An objective of this committee is to stay up to date on local and state issues affecting our membership and the way we conduct business and to keep the General Membership apprised of these issues.

\_\_\_ **Professional Development Committee** - Members who have an interest in developing the professionalism of all members (primarily REALTORS®) through educational programs. This committee deals with developing the professional skills needed for all members to succeed. Planning the educational programs needed to help new and existing members of the Association to excel in our profession is a key objective. This is a really GREAT committee to start with if you have never been involved before. Business Partners may also participate but participation is limited to the Chair and Vice Chair of the Business Partner Committee and 3 additional Business Partners.

\_\_\_ **Professional Standards** - This committee is responsible to process complaints deemed by the Grievance Committee to be valid and in need of possible disciplinary action. Members must have served on Grievance a minimum of 3 years to be eligible to move up to the Professional Standards Committee. An appointment to this committee is a 3 year appointment.

\_\_\_ **RPAC (Realtor Political Action Committee) and Advocacy** - Fundraising is a major piece and objective of this committee. Additionally, this committee will create programs and write newsletter articles to educate the membership on the importance and the purpose of the PAC. This committee will strive to achieve the fundraising goals established for our Association in both dollars and member participation.

\_\_\_ **Young Professionals Network (YPN)** - This committee determines the communication, information and education necessary to reach out to young professional members; provides an opportunity to discuss issues that affect their business.
